### Supported Study

- Held every Monday lunchtime in T011. A chance to get extra help with any area of the course or home learning tasks.

### Assessment type and frequency

- There are 3 units of study. Each unit contains Key Areas that are internally assessed. Students must achieve over 50% combined for all Key Areas for each unit as well as Problem Solving questions.
- N5 students must complete 1 piece of internally marked coursework – an Outcome 1 (investigative report).
- N5 students must complete an externally marked Assignment.
- N5 - There will be a prelim in January 2016 and the exam is externally marked.
- N4 students must complete 2 pieces of internally marked coursework – a 2.2, 2.3 short report and an Outcome 1 (investigative report).
- N4 students must complete an internally marked Added Value Unit.
