1) An S2 into S3 Learner Review form

This provides you with information on how your son / daughter can select their subjects for S3. When discussing this form with your child, you will find it helpful to refer to your child's most recent tracking report, which was issued on Friday 12 January. The key factors for your child when deciding on courses for S3 include:

- Enjoyment of the subject
- The best prospects for the highest possible academic success in S4
- Progression to the Senior Phase in S4/5/6
- Future employment ambitions

Over the next two weeks, there will also be support in classes to help your son / daughter make the right choice of subject for them for S3. Please mark his / her preferred choice of subjects for S3 as instructed on the form. The form should be returned to Mrs J Ramsay DHT by Thursday 8 February at the latest.

Individual Learner Reviews will begin on **Friday 9 February**, the day after the Parent Consultation Evening. This is an opportunity for your child to discuss their choice of subjects for S3 with a member of the school's Student Support Team.

The Broad General Education Explained

S3 is the third year of your child's Broad General Education. He / she will continue to develop his / her learning through the Experiences and Outcomes up to level 3 or 4 and at the start of S3 will have an opportunity to select a preferred focus subject within each curricular area.

Across S1-3, opportunities for learning and teaching continue to be influenced by the four Contexts of Learning

- The ethos and life of the school as a community
- Curriculum areas and subjects
- Interdisciplinary learning
- Opportunities for personal achievement

In S3 all learners can expect their entitlements to be delivered, whatever their individual aspirations and needs, wherever their learning takes place.
