If you select this service your results will arrive from 8am on Tuesday 8 August 2017. You need to sign up to MySQA by 5pm on 18 July, and activate your account by 5pm on 19 July. Registration is simple. You need your Scottish Candidate Number (SCN) and an e-mail address. Tap or click here to register for MySQA

Look out for information about our new ParentPay system on our school website.

ParentPay enables you to pay for trips and other items; offers a highly secure payment site; gives you a history of all the payments you have made; shows you all items available for payment relevant to each of your children; emails a receipt of your payment to the email address you register; offers you the ability to set automated email/SMS payment reminders.

We will send you an activation letter containing your activation details to enable you to set up your ParentPay account.

If you have more than one child at a ParentPay school/s you can add them to a single account, providing one login for all children at ParentPay schools.


#### English Faculty News - S1 7ASS Award
