Apply	7. Write an interview with a member of a rescue team working to save people after a natural disaster. What did they see/hear/feel? 10 points	8. If you lived in Japan, how would you live so that you would be prepared for an earthquake? Write a list of events/ideas. 10 points.	9. Construct a timeline of 10 earthquakes in chronological order. Write where they were and how strong they were. 10 points
Analyse	10. What 3 types of short-term aid and 3 types of long-term aid do places and people need after an earthquake? Explain your choices. 15 points	11. Create an A4 poster comparing the Nepal and Japan Earthquake. 15 points	12. What different skills do you need to be a successful geographer? What jobs could you do? 15 points
Evaluate	13. Do you agree with the statement: ' <i>Volcanos are more dangerous than Tsunamis</i> '. Write an extended 'yes and no' answer. 20 points	14. Would you recommend a person to use paper map skills or digital map skills? Explain your answer in either a poster or extended writing. 20 points	15. Consider a volcanic eruption and the impact on the people and landscape. Research this and pick up a template to complete your answers. 20 points
