##### Every Day:

  - Check Microsoft Office Teams for work and communications from subject teachers.

##### S1 & S2 Learning@Home:

- A timetable will be published weekly on the school website as a guide.
- Each 'lesson' in the timetable is expected to last 60mins as CEC Edinburgh Learns recommends up to 4 hours of work each day.
- Lessons for the full week ahead will be available each Tuesday through Microsoft Office Teams.
- Relevant subject submissions will be due on the Monday.
- We aim to provide regular subject feedback dependent on staff availability.
