If your son/daughter is already using the LFD tests then please note that testing should not take place week 1 of the holidays but should resume week 2.

SQA Matters

We have been working hard putting together plans for the Alternative Certification Model (ACM) which replaces SQA Examinations next term. Please note that the majority of these assessments will take place **10 May – 4 June inclusive**. A detailed timetable will be issued week beginning 20 April.
