

Edinburgh COVID-19 testing sites and vaccination bus locations week beginning 10th January 2022

1ST AND 2ND DOSES

We are still encouraging those who have yet to receive their first dose or who are now due their second dose of the COVID vaccine to come forward.

In line with national guidance, drop in sessions are also now open to those aged 12-15 who are 12 weeks since their first dose and have not had Covid-19 in the last 12 weeks.

1st, 2nd dose and COVID booster vaccinations

- **Edinburgh International Conference Centre**, The Exchange, 150 Morrison St, Edinburgh EH3 8EE. Open every day 9am-5pm.
- **Lowland Hall, Royal Highland Vaccination Centre**, Ingliston Road, Ingliston, Newbridge EH28 8NB, **everyone over 12 can attend this drop-in clinic as well as utilising booked appointments.** Open everyday 8am-6:30pm

In addition to the mass vaccination centres, vaccinations are also available at the following:

Asymptomatic Testing Sites

Testing for people with no COVID-19 symptoms – no appointment necessary

- **McDonald Library**, 2-8 McDonald Rd, Edinburgh EH7 4LU, 9am-6pm, Mon-Sat, **Monday 13th December to Saturday 22nd January 2022 (closed Sundays).** You can also pick up home testing kits here.
- **Blackhall Library**, 56 Hillhouse Road, Edinburgh, EH4 5EG, 9am-6pm, **Monday 10th Jan to Saturday 22nd Jan 2022 (closed Sundays).** You can also pick up home testing kits here.

Mobile Testing Units

These units are walk-in - you do not need to make an appointment. They are run by the Scottish Ambulance Service for people with no symptoms and offer PCR tests. You will be sent your result in 24 to 72 hours.

- **The Faith Mission Bible College** (carpark), 2- 4 Drum Street from **Monday 10 January to Sunday 16 January, 10am to 4pm**
- **Forth Road Bridge Administration Office** (carpark), South Queensferry EH30 9QU, from **Monday 10 January to Sunday 16 January, 10am to 4pm**
- **Saughton Park** (Ford's Road car park), from **Monday 10 January to Sunday 16 January, 10am to 4pm**

Boosters

Everyone over the age of 18 is to be offered an appointment for a booster vaccine, providing three months has passed since they received their second dose of the vaccine.

Anyone aged 18 and over (as well as all priority groups invited previously) can now book their own appointment for a COVID-19 booster vaccination.

It's worth remembering that this is an advance booking facility, so you will be able to book an appointment for 12 weeks from the date of your second dose.
