



Dear Parents/Carers,

I regret to inform you of a boiler fault in school which means that we have no heating across Tynecastle High School. Clearly with the external temperature and our need to keep windows open at times to allow air flow – this presents working conditions and concerns for students and staff (building too cold).

*At present, due to the conditions, we are not able to open at 8.30am today as planned so please **do not send your child to school**. We are in ongoing discussions with the council buildings and maintenance team to find a solution to allow us to open later today at some point. The position at present looks challenging despite efforts, but the Council Team are working on solutions.
I wanted to keep parents, students and families aware of this frustrating development as soon as possible.*

Please be ready to receive updates on our website and by email over the course of today where we will keep you informed of the latest position. As soon as we have clearance to allow students and staff back in the building to begin our 2022 school year, we will.
