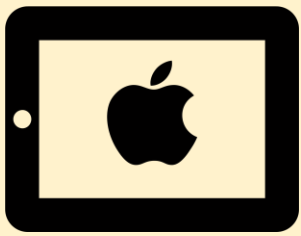


1. Make text bolder

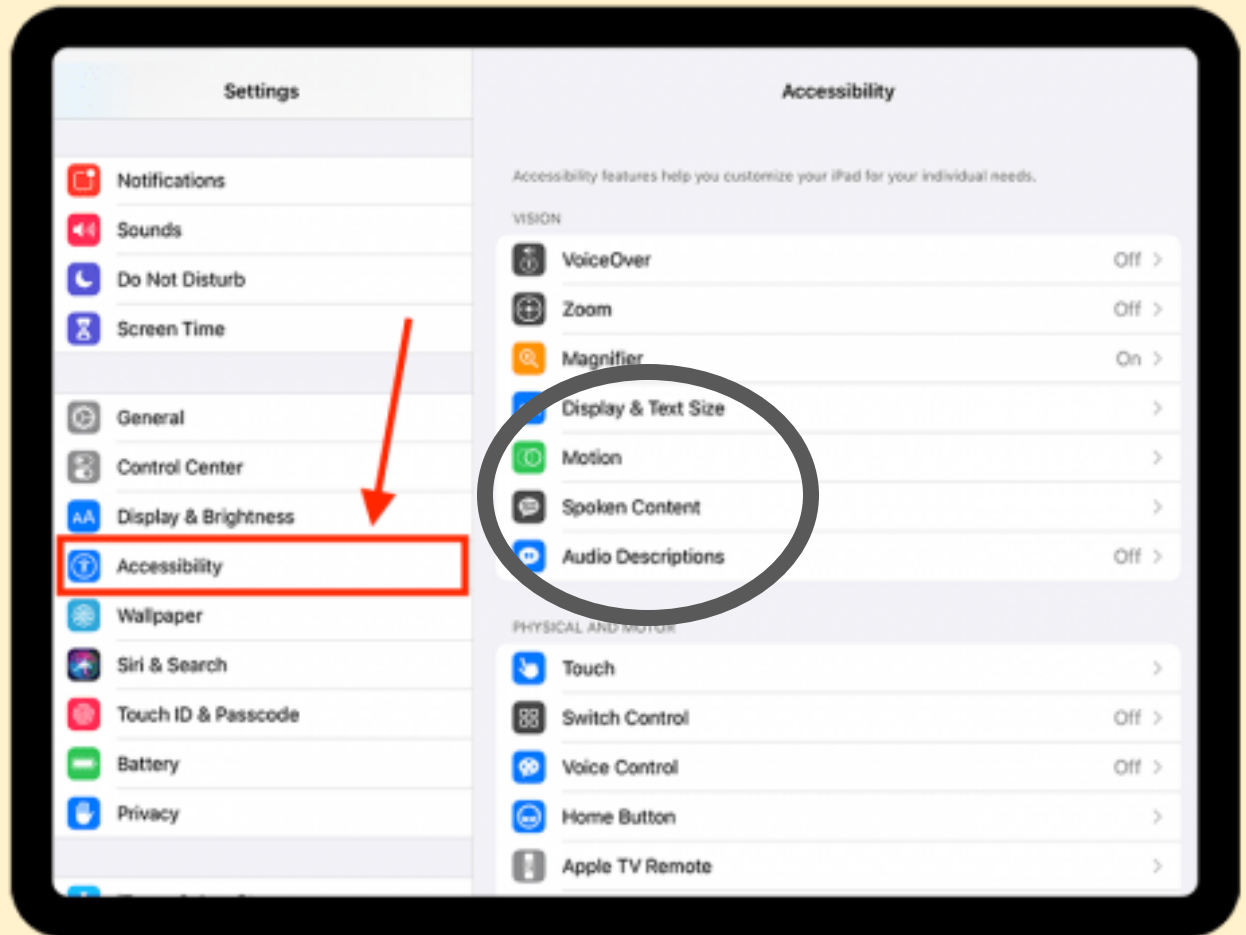
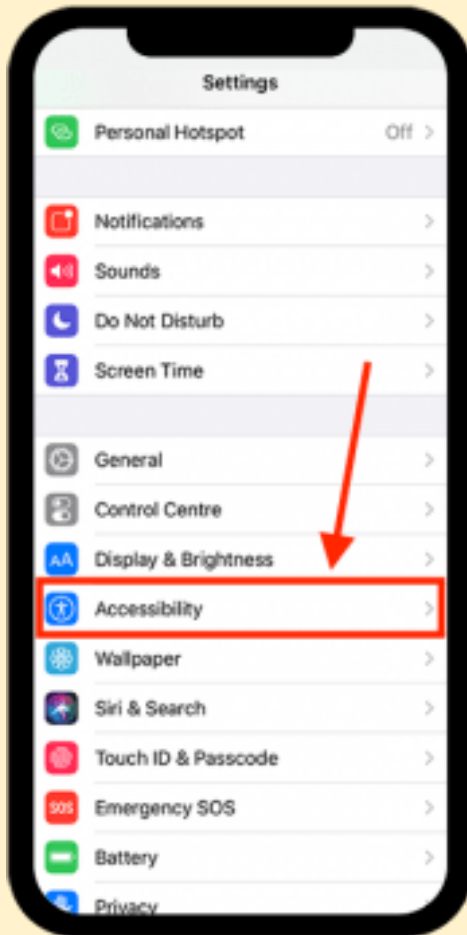
2. Make text larger

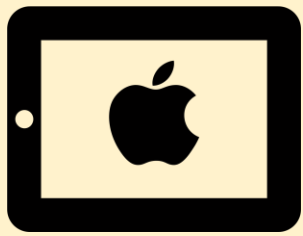
3. Inverting colours on iPad can make it easy to read

Colour filters act like overlays – **Go to Colour Filters → On → Intensity and Hue**

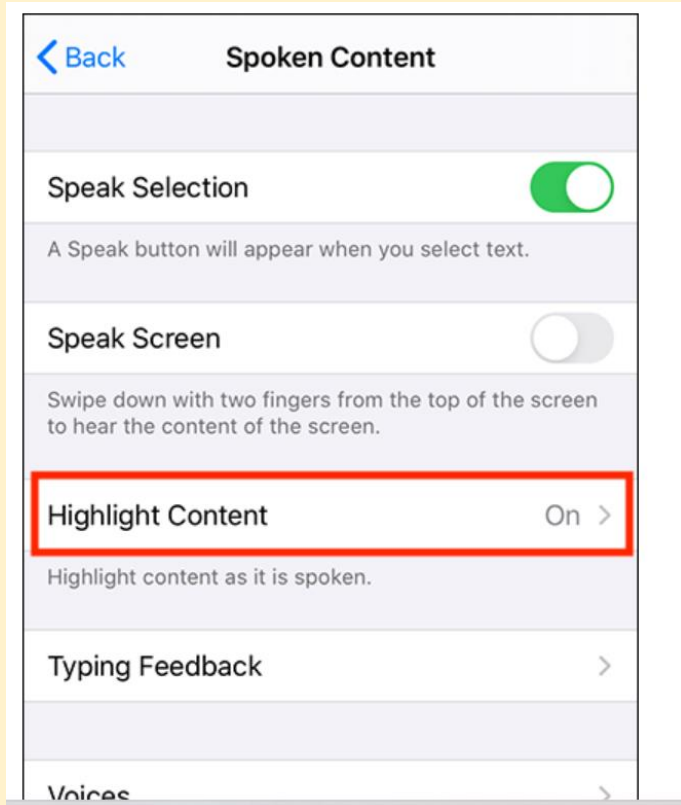

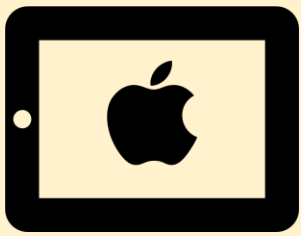


Spoken Content: Speak Selection



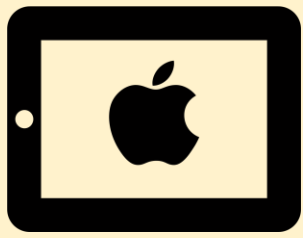
Able to speak any content you highlight on the screen

Voice speed can be altered

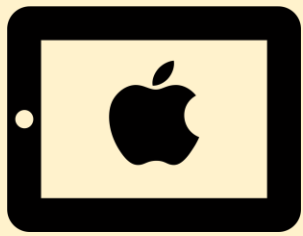
Slide bar up to hare for a faster speaking rate

Slide bar down to turtle for a slower speaking rate

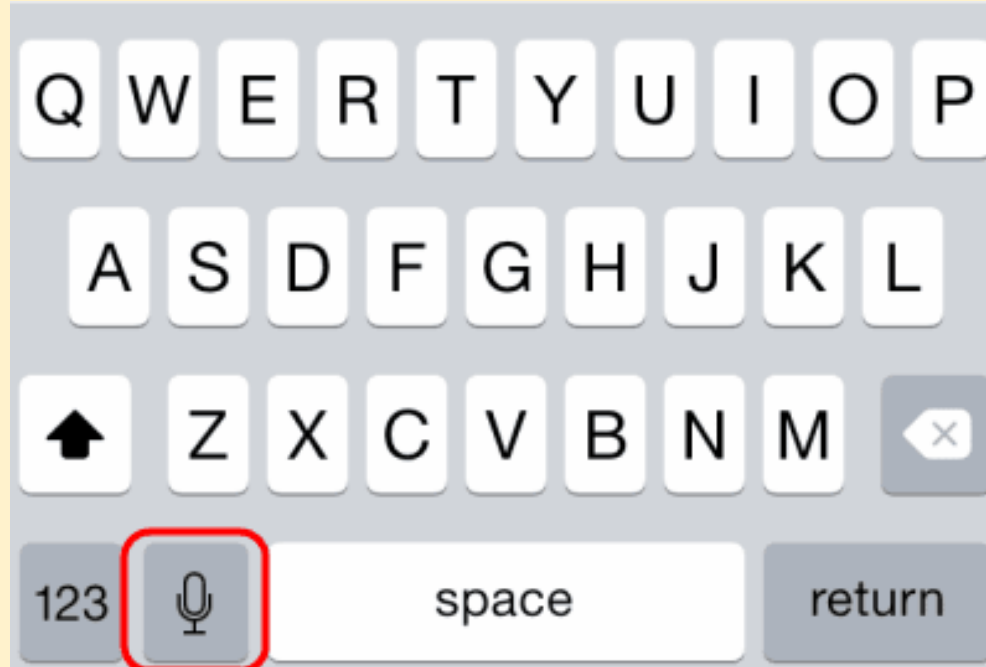
Voice type can be changed to male/ female

Make sure you are selecting English for school.





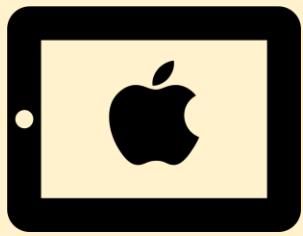

Break it down

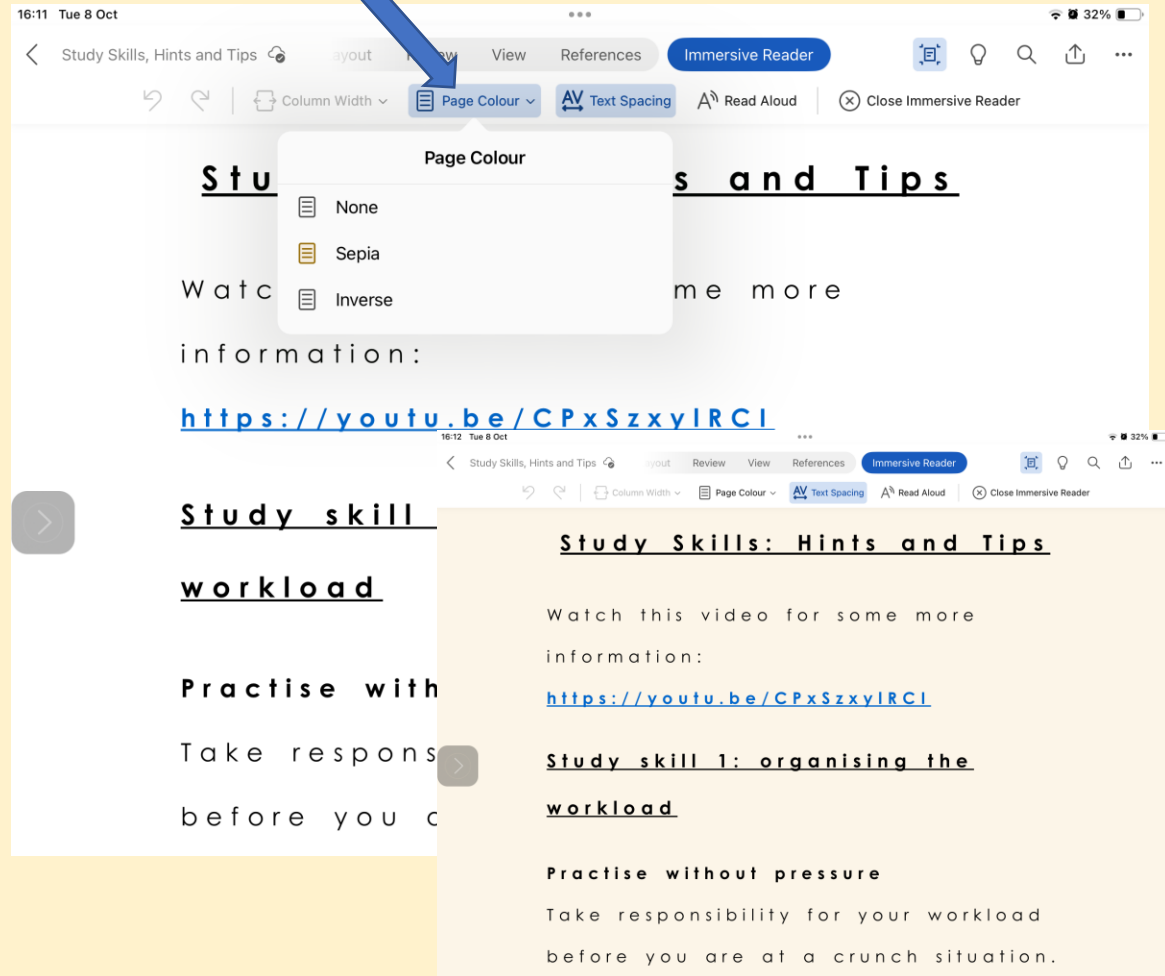
Break a task down into manageable sections. Rather than looking at the essay as a whole, separate it out into planning, researching, writing. Then, when writing think first about the introduction, then the middle and lastly the end. This was it feels more manageable.

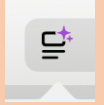


Safari: Show Reader

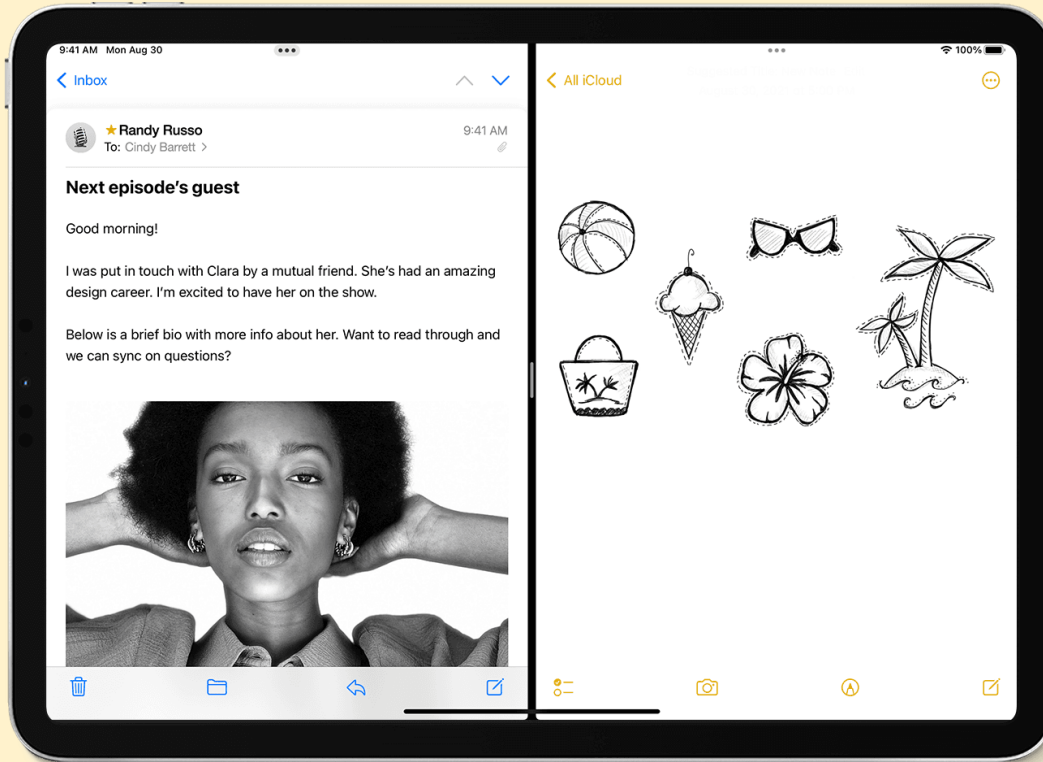
If you split the screen and open the Notes app you can take notes from the website

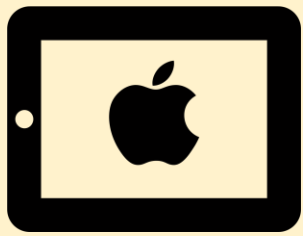

Split Screen Function and Notes

Types of multitasking

Apps that support multitasking can be used in a few different ways.



Split View: In Split View, two apps appear side by side. You can resize the apps by dragging the slider that appears between them.

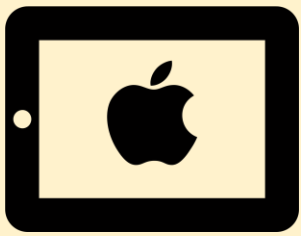


Slide Over: With Slide Over, one app appears in a smaller floating window that you can drag to the left or right-hand side of your screen.



Centre window: In some apps, you can open a centre window that lets you focus on a specific item, such as an email or a note.

Split Screen Function and Notes

How to use the Multitasking menu to open multiple iPad apps

1. Open an app.
2. Tap the Multitasking button **⋮** at the top of the screen.
3. Tap the Split View button  or the Slide Over button . The current app moves aside and your Home Screen appears.
4. Tap a second app on your Home Screen. (Swipe left or right to see apps on your other Home Screen pages. You can also tap an app in your Dock).
 - If you chose Split View, the second app appears side by side with the current app.
 - If you chose Slide Over, the second app opens in full screen and the current app moves to a smaller window that you can move to the right or left-hand side of your screen.
